#### AGENDA ITEMS

#### 1. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (Comp Plan)

An update was provided on the Comp Plan. Discussion revolved around policies for multifamily and single-family zones which were particularly specific and were more "Municipal Code" in nature. The group agreed to reword those policies to be more general and provide for more flexibility to adjust the Municipal Code to meet the current and future needs. A draft Comp Plan should be available by the end of the month.

#### 2. PUBLIC WORKSHOP DISCUSSION

The PC filtered through the list of comments and discussed what they heard at the Public Workshop. Many of the suggestions are beyond the scope of the PC such as Economic Development, features at parks, types of new businesses, operations, etc. The PC discussed the items that involve planning and made sure the goals and policies in the Comp Plan are inclusive of what the community wants.

#### 3. MULTI-FAMILY ZONING

Specifics regarding codes associated with Multi-family zoning were not discussed. PC made sure goals and policies in the Comp Plan where general and inclusive enough to allow flexibility for any potential code changes. The focus was to make sure the Comp Plan goals and policies are aligned with the community's vision and are reflected as such.
