## ANNOUNCEMENT & INFORMATION

Public hearing for the annexation of a parcel on Evergreen Road will occur at the end of March.

Public Forum scheduled for 6:00 PM March 21st at Riverside Center. The City will discuss the PROS Plan and Lagoon Development, Chelan County will discuss the trail plan and North Central Libraries will discuss the potential move to Riverside Center.

## AGENDA ITEMS

## Joint meeting with City Council

The main topics brought forward at the joint meeting were related to managing growth. Discussion revolved around the idea of rezoning areas into high, medium and low-density zones. A multistory apartment building would be an example of high density, townhouses would be medium density and single-family homes on individual lots would be low density development. Other topics included reducing lot sizes for all zones, encouraging multi-family development along transportation routes and extending utility lines. These ideas would be within the city limits and the Urban Growth Area (UGA). Currently, Cashmere has adequate space to grow within the current UGA according to projected growth. Any discussion about expanding or adjusting the UGA will need to be coordinated with, and approved by, Chelan County.

## 2. Parks, Recreation and Open Space (PROS) Plan

The survey is ready to share and receive input from the public. The format of the forum will be to have short presentations by the City to discuss the PROS plan and lagoon development ideas, Chelan County Natural Resources to discuss the trails plan and the North Central Libraries to discuss he potential move to the Riverside Center. After presentations each of the four major topics will have an area with displays to discuss and receive specific input. For the PROS and Lagoon Development there

will be some way for people to "cast a vote" for their priorities. Outreach will be though the Cashmere Record, press releases to other news media, Facebook posts, Baptist Church reader board, flyers in business and information to the schools. Notices will have the web link and QR code to story map and survey. All are encouraged to attend and spread the word.





# Q2 How often do you visit parks in Cashmere?



# Q3 Over the past year, which City parks have you visited? Choose all that apply. Click here to view an interactive map of the parks in a new window.



# Q4 At the parks listed in question #3, which activities do you participate in? Choose all that apply.








# Q5 How do you rate the City parks listed in question #3?




# Q6 Would you have used the City's swimming pool if it was open this past summer?


# Q7 When the Cashmere swimming pool is open, how would you rate the following aspects?







## **Current Plan Goals**

### **Parks and Recreation Facilities Goals**

#### **General Goal:**

Provide safe, clean and attractive parks and recreation facilities in adequate numbers and diversity distributed throughout the community now and into the future.

#### **Program Goals and Policies:**

PRG 1.0 Develop a well-maintained, interconnected system of multi-functional parks, trails, recreation facilities, and open spaces that <u>areis</u> attractive, safe and available to all <u>residents of Cashmere segments of the City's population</u>, and supports the community's established neighborhoods and small town atmosphere.

Note: Each PRG has several associated policies. I am not including them here so we focus on the goals at this time.

- PRG 2.0 Ensure that new park and recreational services are provided concurrent with new development.
- PRG 3.0 Develop, operate and maintain parks and recreation facilities in a manner that is responsive to the site, and balances the needs of the community with available funding.
- PRG 4.0 Cooperate with other jurisdictions, public agencies, and the private sector to provide park, open space and recreation facilities.
- PRG 5.0 Protect and preserve as open space areas that: are ecologically significant sensitive areas; provide significant opportunities for restoration buffers between uses and link open space; provide trails and/or wildlife corridors; or enhance fish habitat.

# **Recreation Program Services**

#### **General Goal:**

Offer diverse, high quality programs to all age groups, interests and ability levels in the most cost effective manner possible.

#### **Program Goals and Policies:**

PRG 6.0 Provide high quality recreation opportunities, facilities and staff that meets the leisure needs of residents and visitors to the community regardless of age, gender, ethnicity or ability level.

# **Organizational Development**

#### **General Goal:**

Create a dynamic, professional organization committed to an ongoing process of innovation.

## **Program Goals and Policies:**

PRG 7.0 Recruit, select and retain volunteers and staff members that represent the City of Cashmere in a favorable manner and exhibit the professional skills reflected in the values of the City including: creativity, excellence, passion, integrity and service.

Encourage the retention of open-space and development of recreational opportunities, conserve fish and wildlife habitat, increase access to natural resource lands and water, and develop parks.
