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POSITION SUMMARY

This is considered an entry level position to learn the basics of Cashmere's public works facilities and operations position and prepare for advancement to other positions.

Maintenance Level I employees will be performing all aspects of public works activities, such as construction, maintenance and operations of streets, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, storm water runoff systems, traffic control devices, cemetery, and parks. Possess a strong work ethic, able to work well with others. Able to represent the City to the public with courtesy and professional behavior

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBLITIES

- Responsible for the safety of the department personnel
- Perform roadway improvements and maintenance such as: excavation, subgrade preparation and asphalt paving, road patching, seal coating, street cleaning and snow removal, and maintain storm water systems
- Placement of traffic control devices to include, but not limited to, guardrail, signs, signals and pavement markings
- Roadside maintenance, including tree trimming, brush and weed control
- General cleaning of all department installations
- Perform all aspects of grave site preparation, funeral services and grave marker placement
- Safe operation and maintenance of power operated tools and equipment
- Building maintenance
- Operate Sprayers applying pesticides or herbicides (if licensed for pesticide)
- Tree pruning, cabling and bracing (if ISA Arborist)
- Perform park maintenance, mowing, and irrigation
- Assist with new water service taps, shut off water meters, replace water meters, read and record water meter use
- Perform other related duties when needed
